### Evidence of achievement

Successful completion of individual units is recognised by the award of a Certificate of Unit Achievement or Certificate of Unit Credit, as appropriate, which lists all units satisfactorily completed.

### Unit Codes

The codes used overleaf to indicate the levels of units are:

D	-unit designed for BTEC Diploma in Foundation Studies (Art and Design).
E 1, 2, 3	-unit designed for BTEC Entry Certificate programmes.
F	-unit designed for BTEC First Diplomas and Certificates.
F/N	-BTEC First level unit in context of BTEC National level programmes.
H, H1, H2	-unit designed for BTEC Higher National Diplomas and Certificates.
N	-unit designed for BTEC National Diplomas, Certificates and Awards.

### Unit Grade

Each successfully completed unit for BTEC qualifications is normally graded Pass, Merit or Distinction. Where the threshold for a Pass in a unit is not achieved this is recorded as Unclassified (U). Gradings of Merit and Distinction are not normally awarded in respect of BTEC Professional Development qualifications and some customised short course units.

(Pass) denotes a unit where the grades Merit and Distinction are not available.

For BTEC First Certificates and BTEC First Diplomas accredited for first teaching from September 2006 there is an additional higher overall grade of D\* (Distinction\*) available.
